

All-Shore Chorus Concert Attire

Students that are not dressed in accordance with the Concert Attire found below will be ineligible to perform in the concert.

Junior Chorus

Men A white, long sleeved, collared dress shirt, black dress pants, black dress shoes with black socks, and a long, solid black neck tie.

Ladies A white, long sleeved, blouse, a solid black skirt falling just below the knee, but not ankle length, solid black stockings or pantyhose, and black dress shoes.

Senior Chorus

Men A white, long sleeved, collared dress shirt, black dress pants, black dress shoes with black socks, and a long, solid black neck tie.

Ladies A white, long sleeved, blouse, a solid black, ankle length skirt, solid black stockings or pantyhose, and black dress shoes.

Please note all shoes and pants must be dress appropriate. Jeans and sneakers will not be permitted.

Appropriate Hair Styles

Hair styles for All-Shore Chorus should be conservative and uniform. Student's hair should be styled in such a manner that it is completely out of the face. Outlandish colors and accessories, including glitter, will not be tolerated. Hair styles should also be close to the head, as students are in close proximity on the risers.

Appropriate Jewelry

Students are encouraged to wear previously earned All-Shore and All-State medals. Personal jewelry, including earrings, necklaces, rings, bracelets, watches, anklets, nose rings, and any other body jewelry, will not be permitted during the performance.

Use of Fragrances

Students must refrain from wearing perfume, cologne, body spray, hairspray, or any other scented products during the performance. These fragrances cause may cause allergic reactions as well as asthma attacks for many students.
